## ICDBG ARP PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND REQUEST FOR CITIZEN PARTICIPATION AND COMMENTS

The Pinoleville Pomo Nation, Tribal Council, publishes this public notice, to inform Tribal Citizens of its intent to apply for the 2021 Indian Community Block Grant (American Relief Plan).

The Nation is applying for \$1,035,000 in federal funding to establish the *Pinoleville Pomo Nation COVID-19 Command Center*. Grant funds will be used to purchase a modular, testing supplies, PPE, software for contact tracing, and other equipment. Public services will also be offered to better help respond to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Nation is publishing this notice in accordance with 24 CFR § 1003.604. In accordance with social distancing measures during the ongoing pandemic, the Nation will not hold an in-person meeting to discuss the project, to protect Tribal Citizen's health and safety.

However, the Nation *will accept and consider all comments on the stated plans for ICDBG funding*.
